**An Important reminder to all seniors and their parents/guardians from
Mr. Beck, Mrs. Yetter, and Dr. Jones about Commencement rehearsals:**

Dear members of the Class of 2023 and their families,

The commencement ceremony for Wyomissing Area Jr. / Sr. High School has been a district tradition since 1924. The order of events, the color and style of the gowns, and the expectations for our graduating classes have remained unchanged for 99 commencement ceremonies. The expectations for the Class of 2023 also remain unchanged. To put it simply, it is extremely important that each member of the Class attend each commencement rehearsal so that the commencement ceremony may be enjoyable for all participants. ***Excused absences must be pre-approved directly with Dr. Jones. Failure to provide an excuse for a missed rehearsal will result in exclusion from participation in commencement activities; no exceptions.***

We would also like to take this opportunity to remind the Class of 2023, and their parents/guardians, about the commencement ceremony dress code. Girls will be expected to wear skirts, dresses, or appropriate pants and blouses. Boys will be expected to wear dress shoes, khakis or dress pants, dress shirts, and preferably a tie. Failure to meet these expectations will result in the forfeiture of your participation in commencement. If a student cannot meet these dress expectations due to an economic hardship, they must contact Dr. Jones, Mrs. Yetter, Mr. Beck, or their Guidance Counselor by 3:00 PM on Friday, May 12th. It is important to understand that the commencement ceremony is a solemn occasion that marks the end of one chapter of a student's life, and the beginning of another, while forever binding them as a group. To treat this occasion as a frivolous event would be a disservice to the Class of 2023 and the past graduating classes of Wyomissing Area High School.

As discussed at our first class meeting, seniors at Wyomissing are expected to be in attendance for at least 90% of the school year in order to be eligible to participate in commencement. Attending commencement is a privilege that is earned through hard work and dedication. Each student has to prove that they have earned this privilege, the same as their classmates have.

We expect that each member of the Class of 2023 will attend each rehearsal for the commencement ceremony, exceed the expectations explained in this letter, and enjoy this final high school experience. In doing so they will be able to stand honorably with the Wyomissing High School, West Reading High School and Wyomissing Area High School classes that have preceded them.

*Young men are asked to wear shirts, ties, pants, dress shoes, and commencement gowns (no caps).

*Young ladies are asked to dress nicely, wear dress shoes, and commencement gowns with the white collars (no caps).

WHAT IS BACCALAUREATE?

Baccalaureate is a traditional ceremony that is held the night before commencement. It is a multi-denominational service that includes music and spiritual leaders from our community. Students join family and friends to give thanks for all of the blessings that have been bestowed upon them. It is simply one final time before commencement for the students to be together and celebrate as a group, so we encourage all seniors to participate. Attendance is not mandatory. Estimated length of the service is one hour.

REMINDERS

*Graduates will not receive their tickets or diplomas if obligations remain unpaid, or if their behavior during the commencement rehearsals and/or ceremony is deemed inappropriate by the administration of WAHS.

*Each graduate will receive **6 tickets** for the ceremony. There will be a sign-up sheet at the 1st rehearsal (5/26) for students who would like additional tickets. There will be a limited number of extra tickets available. Additional tickets will be evenly distributed among all who request them. Mr. Beck and Mrs. Yetter will distribute all tickets at the second commencement rehearsal (5/30).

*Graduates are to arrive at the SRC Cafeteria no later than 5:30 p.m.

* Dress Code: Girls: Dresses, skirts, or dress pants and a blouse
 Boys: Khakis or dress pants, dress shirts, dress shoes and preferably a tie

~No Jeans - No Sneakers - No Shorts~

*After the commencement ceremony, graduates are to keep their gowns, but must report to the SRC cafeteria to receive their actual diplomas.

*At the conclusion of the ceremony, students will process from the seating area to the SRC cafeteria to get their graduate packets. Once they have received their packet, they can return to the Auditorium to meet with their families. ***We ask that the audience remain in the auditorium until the graduates return.***

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT COMMENCEMENT

Q. What do we do if we need more than 6 tickets for the commencement ceremony?

A. First, ask friends if they have extras. There are a limited number of extra tickets, which will be shared evenly with those who request them. To sign up for extra tickets, students should see **Mr. Beck or Mrs. Yetter at the first commencement rehearsal**. Tickets will be evenly distributed among those who signed up for additional tickets at the first rehearsal.

Q. If my child signs up for extra tickets, is it guaranteed that we will receive the number of tickets he/she requested?

A. No.

Q. If a senior loses his/her commencement tickets, will the tickets be replaced?

A. No; there will be no additional tickets available so please keep your tickets in a safe place.

Q. Where should we park for the commencement ceremony?

A. Parking is available in the following places: the parking lots adjacent to the venue, Campus Road, Parkside Drive North, South Park Road and the Reading Public Museum parking lot on Parkside Drive South.

Q. What type of seating will be available for spectators at commencement?

A. The Scottish Rite Cathedral is essentially a large auditorium, with left, center and right sectioned Orchestra and Balcony seating.

Q. What if special seating for a handicapped individual is needed?

A. If you need handicapped accessible seating for the commencement ceremony, please call Mrs. Janice Duquette (610-374-0739, ext. 2132) by 2:00 p.m. Tuesday, May 30th. A reserved seat will be available for the handicapped individual plus one family member. The seats will not be designated by name. The reserved seats will be filled on a first-come, first-served basis.

Q. Should we iron the commencement gown?

A. To make the gown look nice and neat for this special event, we suggest you iron the gown on the LOW HEAT setting only, or hang the gown on a hanger in the bathroom. Steam from the shower will soften the wrinkles and no ironing may be needed.

Q. May graduates keep the gown, cap and tassel?

A. Yes.

Q. Why will seniors return to the SRC Cafeteria after the ceremony?

A. Upon returning to the SRC Cafeteria, graduates will be subject to a final check of any financial obligations before the distribution of diplomas.

Q. Are all commencement rehearsals mandatory?

A. Yes. All seniors must take part in all of the commencement rehearsals. The entire event is choreographed so that everything flows smoothly with a sense of dignity that should mark such an occasion. Attendance will be taken at each rehearsal. Dr. Jones reserves the right to exclude any senior from the commencement ceremony for not attending a rehearsal. All absences must be pre-approved by Dr. Jones. ***Commencement rehearsal is open only to graduating seniors and WAHS staff directly involved in the commencement ceremony.***

Q. Who should my child see to satisfy obligations?

- A. Library obligations ~ see Mrs. Balatgek, Mr. Ackerman, or Mrs. Caruso
Cafeteria obligations ~ see Mrs. Marrero in the Cafeteria
Athletic obligations ~ see Mrs. Stern in Athletics
Technology obligations ~ see Technology Staff, Lobby Concession Stand on May 25th.
Parking tags ~ should be given to Mrs. Duquette in the Principal's office
All other obligations ~ see Mrs. Jones, Attendance Office
All payments must be made by check or money order, payable to WASD (No cash).

Q. Can we take pictures during the ceremony?

- A. You are welcome to take pictures, however ***flash photography is strictly prohibited*** as it will temporarily blind the graduates and speakers. If you would like to pose for pictures before the ceremony, the grounds of the adjacent Reading Public Museum should provide an excellent location. Graduates will be available for pictures at the conclusion of the ceremony, but please keep in mind they must return to the Scottish Rite cafeteria to receive their diplomas.

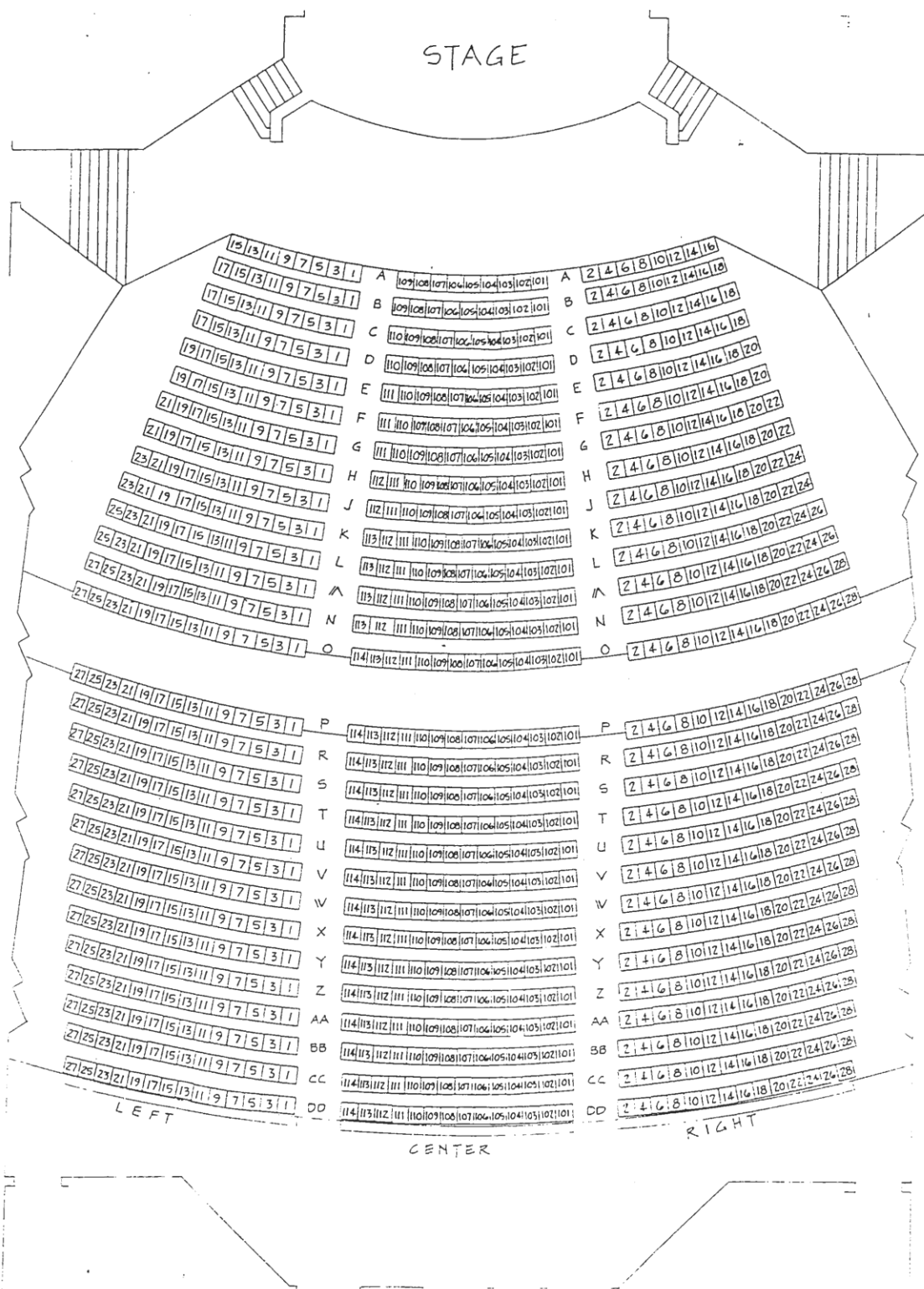

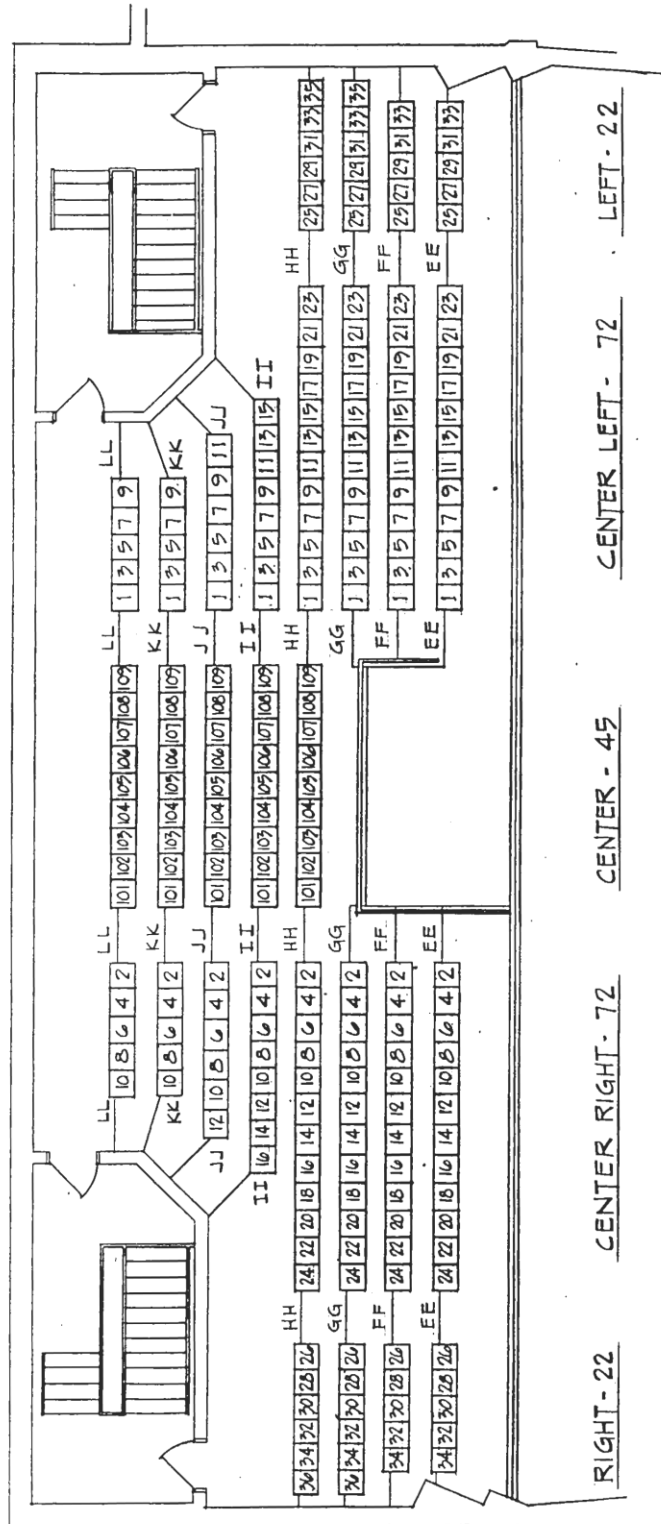

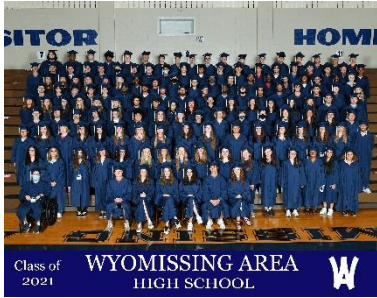

If you ordered a mini-diploma, please know that it will be mailed directly to your home after graduation.

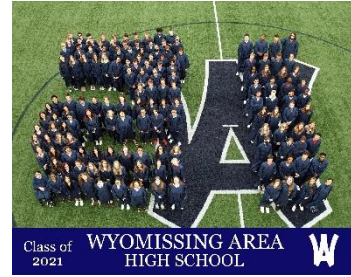
