

# AP Psychology Summer Assignment

**Directions:** You will take a survey of the first chapter in AP Psychology. You will do this by reading and completing an interactive notebook on Pear Deck. Complete all of the activities in the Pear Deck. Be sure to click the link at the bottom of this page to access the Pear Deck assignment. **Be sure that you are logged on to your school google account to complete the assignment.** There is also a brief instructional video link included to help you with the tech aspects of this assignment.

**The purpose** of the assignment is to introduce you to the major figures who contributed to the development of the discipline of psychology. You will also be introduced to the various subfields of psychology and the various approaches psychologists use to explain behavior and mental processes. There will be a short quiz given the first week of school that covers the information in this assignment.

**The time required to complete this assignment** should be about 2-4 hours. There are about 25 google slides to look at. Some slides have an embedded video to watch and questions to answer. Some slides have multiple-choice questions to answer. Some slides just have text to read. Some slides ask you to write a brief paragraph. There is nothing to submit; everything you complete will be saved automatically and I will be able to view your responses in my teacher dashboard.

**The volume** of this summer assignment consists of completing the activities in all of the 25 google slides of the interactive notebook.

The assignment should be completed by **Monday August 21<sup>st</sup>**. This is one week before the start of school. This will allow me to have time to evaluate it and write comments to you. .
